British Library Catalogue

WEG has numbered the pages of the notebook in ink from 1 to 51 on the top outside edges of the pages. The British Museum processor has numbered the recto pages that have writing on them sequentially in pencil and has crossed out WEG's pagination. On this basis, the processor calculated the number of folios in the notebook to be 29.

The list in the notebook maps on to WEG's No 3, a list of alphabetical names of letters to WEG. He has used three different sections of the notebook in order to allow further insertions of names. The following list is a reconstruction intended to maintain the list in its entirety. [????] indicates an illegible name in the notebook.

First leaf, pencil p. 2; WEG p. 1

My letters are kept in three sets.

1. Chronological: a series of packets from my boy-hood to this time.
2. Letters in a series of bundles on particular subjects: with which they are marked.
3. Letters from particular persons: see Alphabetical List. †† This list includes all my Colleagues in Cabinets.

4. My wife's letters are kept apart.
5. Letters written by me are kept apart. With these are letters on family history: on passages of political life: on published works
